News from Kuala Lumpur

The RPSC has received an official invitation to participate in MALAYSIA 2014 the FIP patronage World Philatelic Exhibition to be held in Kuala Lumpur on December 1-6, 2014. The exhibition, in a change from previous announcements, now will have three competitive classes.

1) The Youth Philately Class will include Youth Literature (philatelic books, pamphlets, studies, journals and periodicals authored by youth only), Open Philately (Experimental)

2) Adult Thematic Philately. This class of philately is very popular in Southeast Asia and allows for a larger exhibition.

3) Adult Modern Philately of the 21st Century.

The number of exhibition frames (4 x 4 = 16 pages each frame) has been expanded to 1,000. Frame fees for the Youth Class exhibits are not charged.

Please check the application form or the IREX (Individual Regulations for the Exhibition) for the Adult frame fees. The closing date for completed application forms is April, 11th 2014. Canadian applicants will want to get their forms into Denis Hamel before April 1st, 2014. An e-mail or telephone call to Canadian Commissioner Denis Hamel is advisable to obtain an entry form and to check on any late news from Kuala Lumpur.

The Society covers France, Colonies, and post-colonial Independent Nations stamps and postal history. A sample copy of the France & Colonies Philatelist is on the website. Plans are under

way for a digital library featuring the early F&C Philatelists issues. The earliest ones date from 1941, the same year the Society was founded.

SINGAPORE 2015 is the 3rd World Stamp Exhibition to be held in the island state of Singapore. It is to be held in conjunction with Singapore's 50th Year of Independence, with the patronage of the FIP and under the auspices of the Federation of Inter-Asian Philately (FIAP).

Singapore last hosted the World Stamp Exhibition in 1995 and the inaugural World Stamp Championship in 2004. The event commemorates Singapore's Golden Jubilee in 2015. The dates of the show are August 14-19, 2015. Note that the dates for upcoming FIP Exhibition frequently get revised so always check the Exhibition websites to confirm the latest dates and information before booking travel and accommodation.
