Future Internationals

It has become quite apparent that the international philatelic exhibitions that formally invite participation by the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada (RPSC) are becoming less frequent and fewer in number. The RPSC International Committee is aware of this development. In order to try and increase the opportunities for Canadian exhibitors, commission-

ers and jurors, I continue to make inquiries of show organizers to try and encourage them to formally invite RPSC participation.

It is strange to me that the European only "international" exhibitions send in news releases promoting their events and ex-

pect free space in the RPSC "Canadian Philatelist" magazine for publicity but fail to officially invite RPSC full participation. Perhaps some of the blame for this is that it has been 20-years since the RPSC has sponsored an "international" show. Perhaps a solution is to declare a future annual Royal/Royale Exhibition and Convention an "International Exhibition" under



FIAF auspices [no charge for this designation is available from the FIAF] and open entries up to our international friends. It worked for our St. Pierre-Miquelon affiliate in 2014.

As a start, I recommend that several of our RPSC exhibitors seriously consider entering their award winning exhibits in the FIAF international exhibition in Cordoba, Argentina. I have undertaken to serve as the RPSC Commissioner to this Hemispheric Inter-Continental exhibition. To this end (see page 2)
