This exhibition will be held under the patronage of FIAF and will include Championship, Traditional, Postal History, Thematic, One Frame and Literature classes. Canada received an invitation to **IBRA 2021** in Essen, Germany. IBRA 2021 is a FIP World Stamp Exhibition with competitive classes in Championship, Traditional, Postal History, Thematic, Revenue, Postal Stationery, Aerophilately, Astrophilately, Open, Picture Postcards, One Frame, Maximaphily, Modern, Literature and Youth. The exhibition will run from May 6 - 9, 2021 with a total of 2800 frames to be exhibited. The regulations (IREX) & application forms are available on the exhibition website [www.IBRA2021.de](http://www.IBRA2021.de). The deadline for exhibit entry applications is **Oct 1, 2020**. Canadian exhibitors have also been invited to participate in **Estonia 2020** which will be held July 10-12, 2020 in Tartu, Estonia. This is not an exhibition for which Canada will be appointing a commissioner, but anyone interested in exhibiting at Estonia 2020 may contact David McLaughlin (email: [david.mclaughlin@rogers.com](mailto:david.mclaughlin@rogers.com)) for more information. Applications for Estonia 2020 are due on March 23, 2020.

**2019 International Exhibiting Year In Review.** There was one FIP exhibition, China 2019, and one FIAF exhibition, Buenos Aires 2019, held in 2019. In total 19 exhibit applications were submitted comprising a total of 89 frames (1424 pages). The applications for 84% of our exhibits representing 83% of frames were accepted by the exhibitions. In 2018, 100% of the exhibitors who applied to more than one exhibition were accepted for at least one exhibition. The same was true again in 2019.

Canada's medals for multi-frame exhibits in 2019, include 1 large gold, 2 gold, 3 large vermeil, 3 vermeil, 1 silver and 1 silver bronze. Single frame points awarded include the equivalents of 1 gold, 1 vermeil, 1 large silver and 1 silver. Remember that in national level judging all of these awards, except large gold would be one medal level higher with equivalent points.

In 2019 Canadian exhibitors competed in a wide range of classes including; Traditional, Postal History, Aerophilately, Open, Youth, One Frame and Picture Post Cards. Ten Canadian exhibit applications in 2019 qualified as first time exhibit entries. Exhibitions welcome new exhibits as FIP requires that 20% of the frames be reserved for them.

Thank you to all the Canadian exhibitors who participated in international exhibiting in 2019 through applications or exhibits.

RPSC is a full member of FIP and FIAF, the continental federation for the Americas, and receives invitations for all shows held under FIP or FIAF patronage.

RPSC is not invited to participate in Continental shows organized by other federations (i.e. FEPA and FIAP) or international shows outside of the Americas held with only FIP recognition status.

In 2022 Canada will host an international exhibition after a 26 year absence, with **CAPEX '22**. Although the final dates and venue are still being finalized it will be a 4 day show at a hotel or convention centre complex in Toronto.

CAPEX 22 will include 400 frames of exhibits plus print and electronic literature classes. All frame exhibits will be in the One Frame class and may be from any parent FIP class including the experimental picture post card class.

The exhibition is being organized by the **Canadian Association of Philatelic Exhibitions – Association Canadienne des Expositions Philatélique**. The Royal Philatelic Society of Canada (RPSC) will host the exhibition and all RPSC chapters and affiliates will be invited to participate in the exhibition with numerous seminars and specialist presentations.

CAPEX '22 received the FIAF Patronage of the Federación Inter-Americana de Filatelia and is finalizing the FIP Recognition with the Federation Internationale de Philatelie.

CAPEX '22 hopes to showcase a broad range of Canadian one frame exhibits and philatelic literature. The qualification for entry of one frame is a vermeil medal at a national level show. As CAPEX '22 is still 30 months away, exhibitors have both 2020 and 2021 to qualify. Exhibits can qualify at either a Canadian or USA WSP shows. **More CAPEX '22 news to come!**
