Hello Fellow Exhibitors

As with the June issue, this month's issue begins with the rescheduling of another international exhibition.

IBRA 2021, Essen, Germany has been rescheduled to 2023. The final date has yet to be decided but it is expected to be held in May 2023. Thanks to Commissioner Ingo Nessel for the work undertaken to recruit Canadian exhibits for IBRA 2021 and to all of the exhibitors who have already applied or have planned to apply. I hope that everyone will continue to support IBRA 2023. Further information on IBRA 2023 will be provided as it becomes available.



Indonesia 2020, Jakarta, Indonesia was rescheduled from August 2020 to November 2020 and a final decision on whether the show would be able to proceed in November was promised for July. No information has been forthcoming from the Organizing Committee as of July 31st, however, given the current Canadian government Level 3 travel advisory, quarantine requirements both in Indonesia and Canada and the continued increase in new daily COVID 19 cases world wide, Canada will withdraw from the November Exhibition. Thank you to all of the applicants for Indonesia 2020. Your interest in exhibiting at the exhibition is very much appreciated. Updates on any rescheduling of Indonesia 2020 or the plans for the FIP 76th Congress will be advised when received.
